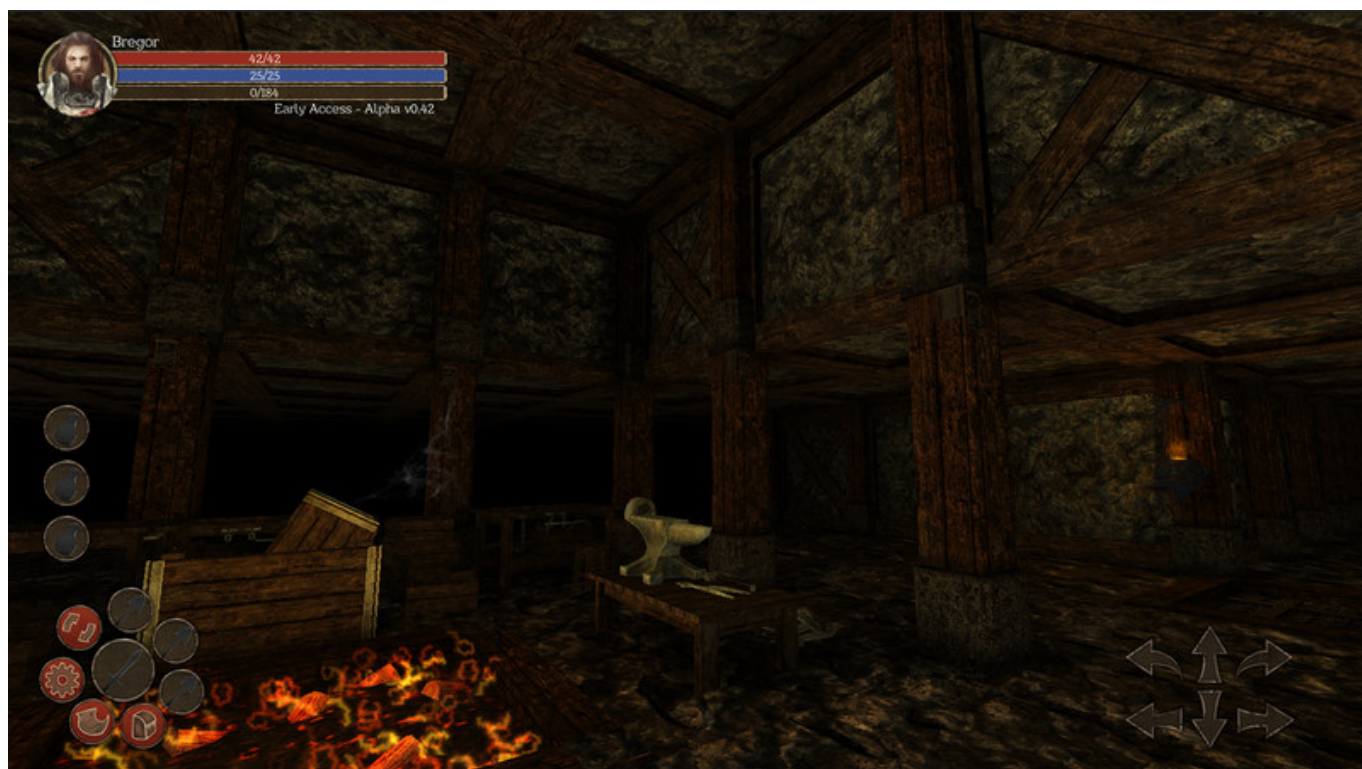

The game always has challenge that change all the time. The design is really well made. The use of Unreal Engine 4 make it look so realistic that you are literally on another world. Overall, it's fantastic. It could be made more replayable and more dynamic if some DLC (i.e. new campaign/stories/chapters, expansion pack, etc.) was added, but otherwise it's pretty good.. This game sucks. Why? Because they can't seem to get the lag out of it. Never again Playway, Mr Muffins!!!!. i am a big fan of multiplayer rts games, and cannot recommend this game.....NOBODY EVER ONLINE!!!!!! EVER!!! So if you buy this game, consider it a single player only. Damn shame cause i think it would be a good multiplayer rts game.

Honestly might be my least favourite nancy drew game, and I've been playing them since the start. While the idea behind playing multiple characters is nice, it doesn't really feel necessary, and the fact that you have to go through Nancy for every switch is tedious.

Graphics, while clean, seem so tiny and old to be laughable till after I started playing, I realized that it's all part of the charm for this game. Where it really shines is game story and playability. Funny jokes and all aside, it feels like a grand rpg experience with as much polish as anything else I've played recently.. First episode is great! It's really interesting to see 2 people sit down and make a game within 48 hours. It's inspiring, which is always something that is a plus with something like this. Highly recommended. Also, the first game, Navigator, is pretty fun!. Cool little game - demonstrates what a room scale game that runs well has the potential to deliver whilst maintaining good graphical content. I like the parody skelton go bang. game not for undercooked egg children go away if you will think you will scare off ease.. If you are going to get Cossacks 3, go big and get all the content with ALL the nations and missions. You won't regret it if you like the base game. Do you remember the game "Godus". Where you had to raise and lower the terrain for your minions to build.

This game has a similar mechanic but instead of limiting what you can do.

Afterwards you choose which people you recruit. It's a number balancing game.

Woodcutter -> Farms -> Blacksmith -> Soldier/Priests

After you figure out that pattern with recruiting. There isn't much else to learn.. Tau is a unique faction with its long range and ability to bring tons of smaller ships. It also has a more diverse fleet compared to the rest which really helps.

Only thing I wish they had was a campaign style mode where each win/loss mattered. It doesn't have to have a story, because that would increase the price, but they could have something similar to the main campaign without the story elements.
